Welcome

This year we are going to meet again at the **4th Ĝ1 Ĝathering 2024** (the annual forum of Libre Currency <https://moneda-libre.org>) which will take place at the Baztan Valley - Navarra, from Thursday August 29th to Sunday September 1st.

This is the fourth year in a row that we will gather in a self-managed space. A space that will allow us to share experiences and learn the numerous possibilities of co-creation that we can generate through our own gifts and talents in June (Ĝ1).

This fourth forum happens after three previous meetings, all of them important to get here today, to the 4th Ĝ1 Ĝathering at the Baztan Valley:

- ✓ 1st Iberian Meeting on Ĝ1 Libre Currency, held in Tiana, Barcelona (from 10 to 12 September 2021).
- ✓ 2nd Iberian Meeting on Ĝ1 Libre Currency, held in Alfafara, Alicante (from 9 to 11 September 2022).
- ✓ 3rd Ĝ1 gathering, held in Miraflores de la Sierra, Madrid (from 6 to 8 October 2023).

Ĝ1 Ĝathering Baztan 2024

We want to provide the conditions for self-management at this event, turning it into an experience where every participant can display their own gifts and talents. This way we allow the exchange of ideas, proposals, goods and services during the four days that the event will last. To participate it is necessary to register in the website <https://moneda-libre.org>, where you can find the information about the location of this meeting, the accommodation options and, later on, the schedule of activities.

This is a gathering based on self-management, which means that we all take care of the tasks and duties related to the activities, the market, the feeding, ...etc.

The distribution of tasks consists in the display of bulletin boards. On this boards there will be the different topics, needs and shifts, so everyone can join accordingly to their gifts, talents and preferences. This way all the tasks will be covered.

The possibilities are endless and it is our responsibility as a collective to make this a safe and structured place.

Remember, to the **Ĝ1 gathering**, as a place for exchange, you don't just come, **you co-create it**.

This Ĝ1 gathering will have room for different kind of activities regarding the Libre currency:

- ◆ Ĝ1 lectures, spaces for reflection and workshops.
- ◆ Market and therapies.
- ◆ Recreational, creative and amusing activities.
- ◆ Meeting and resting spaces.
- ◆ Youth and children's areas.

Location

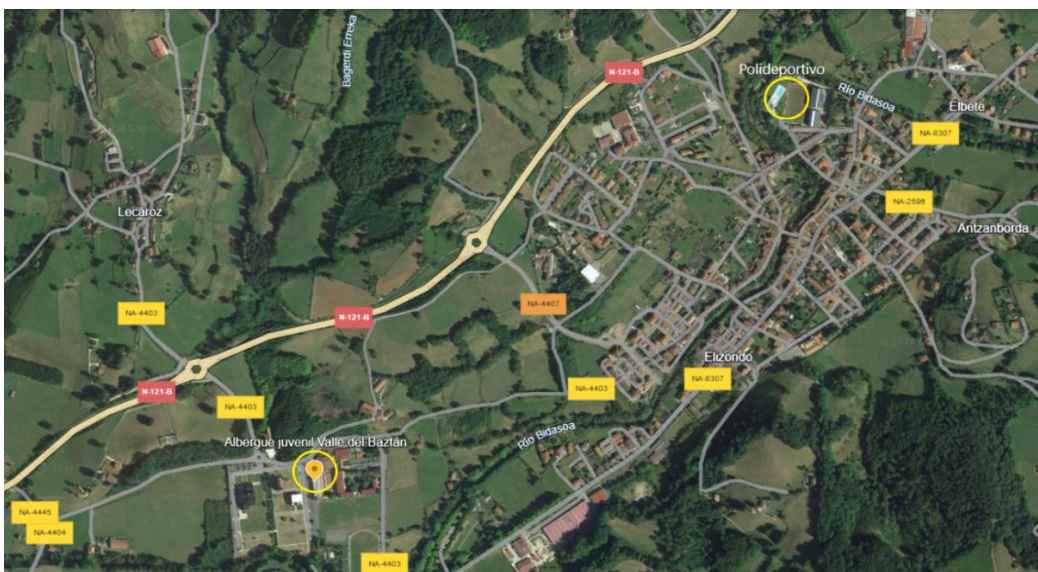
The Baztan Valley is an area full of history written in the mountains and the landscape, and also turned into handicraft, palaces, buildings, paths and places. From the area you can learn legends about the inhabitants of every town, whose ancient origin remind us of traditional knowledges that are connected with nature and the beauty of the landscape. A landscape full of steep mounts, beautiful forests and pristine waters nourishing life in every corner around the valley.



Baztan Valley

The Baztan Valley it is located north of the Iberian Peninsula, right in the heart of Euskal-Herria. It has 376,81 square kilometers, which makes it the largest municipality in Navarra and the Pyrenean valleys. The valley is formed by 15 villages distributed in 4 areas¹, being Lekaroz the village where the Hostel is, and the center of the Ğ1 gathering.

Accommodation

We will stay at the Youth Hostel “Valle del Baztan” in Lekaroz, fully booked for this event, our Ğ1 gathering. It is a barrier free two-floor public building with bedrooms and event rooms. The Hostel is managed by Aspace foundation (<https://aspacenavarra.org/lekaroz>) and it accommodates groups, pilgrims from the Baztan route of the Way (Camino de Santiago), and also tourists and travelers in general.

It is located a little more than 1km from Elizondo, the capital of the Baztan Valley, where the townhall makes the local sports center facilities available to the Ğ1 gathering, in particular the showers for the guests that sleep in camper vans and similar vehicles.

The Hostel can accommodate 200 Ğ1 users in shared bedrooms with 6 or 10 beds.



There are showers, full bathrooms and toilets with hot water, a dining room for breakfast and a coffee area that will be used as a living room and a lunchroom in June (Ğ1). Bed linen is included.



Hostel facilities include free Wi-Fi and:

- ◆ Events room.
- ◆ Multipurpose room.
- ◆ Audiovisual equipment.
- ◆ Meeting rooms for teamwork and activities.
- ◆ Coffee area and/or living room.



Ĝ1 price list and registration fee.

Registration fee to participate in the Ĝ1 gathering:

- ◆ **22DU** persons aged 11 and over.
- ◆ **7DU** children between the ages of 3 and 10.
- ◆ Free for children under the age of 3.

Available rooms:

- ◆ 4 shared rooms for 6 people, with a shared bathroom out of the bedroom.
- ◆ 16 shared rooms for 10 people, with a shared bathroom out of the bedroom.

Prices per person in a shared room, including the three nights and 4 days of the event:

- ◆ Shared room for 6 people: 87€ per person.
- ◆ Shared room for 10 people: 87€ per person.
- ◆ Children between the ages of 3 and 10: 70€

The accommodation in the shared rooms includes breakfast (Hostel terms and conditions).

- ◆ Motorhomes, camper vans and similar vehicles; registration fee is 15€ per person (breakfast not included).

For everyone staying out of the hostel, registration fee is 15€ if you are older than 11 years old and 10€ for children between the ages of 3 and 10.

* Free access for children under the age of 3.

Fiat currency guarantees the use of the meeting rooms at the hostel and it will help with the expenses of setting-up the place. It will also help with the materials and the de-capitalization of the goods that will be used to guarantee the well-functioning of the event.

What to bring.

ACCOMODATION

The hostel provides bed linen BUT NOT towels or personal care products.

You should bring: towel, flip-flops, sleepwear, EARPLUGS, and everything you may need for personal care (shower gel, shampoo, toothpaste, sunscreen, ...).

FOOD

As a collective we will self-manage the meals, so everything you want to contribute is welcome. It is necessary to bring a plate, a glass and cutlery for personal use.

LEISURE, WORKSHOPS AND MARKET

You are invited to bring anything you think could benefit the event to be a creative space that facilitates sharing and learning.

- ◆ Music instruments.
- ◆ Juggling and acrobatics.
- ◆ Paintings, writing materials...
- ◆ Fabric that you don't use anymore (scarfs, bedsheets, table clothes, ...)
- ◆ A mat.
- ◆ Camping table and chairs.
- ◆ Everything you may need to set-up your booth in the market.

CLOTHING

Check the weather as the event approaches, usually it is unstable and tends to be rainy.

- ◆ Swimming suit (there is a river nearby)
- ◆ Mountain footwear.

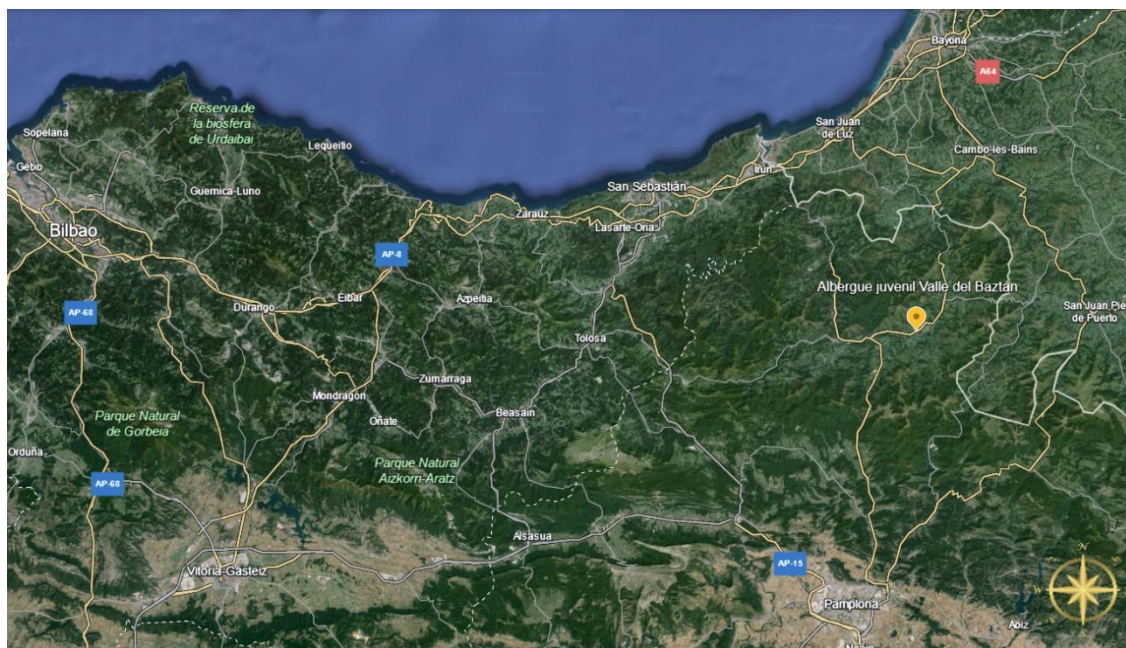
PERSONAL CARE

How to get there



Baztan Valley is located north of the province of Navarra, 50 minutes away from Pamplona (take the road N-121-A) and one hour away from San Sebastián. Check the distance between places so you can choose the best route for you:

- Iruña / Pamplona: 54 Km.
- Donostia / San Sebastián: 64 Km.
- Bilbo / Bilbao: 161 Km.
- Gasteiz / Vitoria: 128 Km.
- Hondarribia: 48 Km.
- Logroño: 152 km.
- Biarritz / Biarritz: 70 Km.
- San Jean de Pied du Port: 39 km.
- Bayona: 55 km.
- San Juan de Luz: 53 km.

By plane, nearest airports are:

Anglet-Biarritz and Donostia-San Sebastián. Other airports: Pamplona, Bilbao, y Vitoria.

ANIMALS

PETS ARE NOT ALLOWED inside the hostel.




If you come with your pet you can stay in a camper van or similar, and of course, you need to take a responsible care of your animal. Even though they are not allowed inside the hostel, the surrounding area is perfect for their recreation.

Anyway, they must be supervised at any time since we are in a rural area with cattle in the surrounding meadows.

CHILDREN

If you come with children and you ticked the box in the registration form, the organization will get in touch with you to figure out how to meet their needs and care as a community.
